Purpose/Objective: Working with Community Food Initiatives' Donation Station is extremely rewarding! Our Donation Station Summer Service Corps Member will work directly with the community, addressing Athens County's most immediate food security issue: access to healthy fresh foods for all. This involves collecting donated local food, as well as monetary donations, used to buy more food directly from local farmers.

Duties & Activities:

- Assist with the management of the Donation Station at an assortment of the following times and locations:
 - Wednesdays at the Athens Farmers Market from 9AM-1PM
 - o Mondays and Thursdays at the Chesterhill Produce Auction from 3PM-7PM (Until Mid-October)
 - Mondays and Fridays at Food Pantry Distribution from 8AM-11AM
- Additional, flexible assignments based on the interests and skills of the chosen intern. May include
 researching farms outside of the Athens Farmers Market and Chesterhill Produce Auction to recruit for the
 Harvest Hotline, developing a marketing plan for the Grow-A-Row Campaign, fundraising, assisting at the
 Donation Station garden plots and attending biweekly staff meetings.

- Energy, with desire to come up with fresh ideas on how to grow the program

- Ability to contribute individually, and participate in a team
